

RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE EFFORTS OF THE NEVADA HEALTHY HOMES PARTNERSHIP AND THE APPLICATION FOR HEALTHY HOMES GRANTS FOR SOUTHERN NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development in coordination with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention have launched an initiative called "Healthy Homes" to address the vital link between housing conditions and occupant health; and

WHEREAS, the University of Nevada Las Vegas, in collaboration with the Southern Nevada Health District and other community partners, has secured funding from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to develop a Nevada Healthy Homes Partnership in the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, the principal areas of intervention in this grant, being structural deficiencies, asthma triggers, poisonings and unintentional injuries, are known to exist in the State of Nevada and are known to have a deleterious effect on the health and safety of its citizenry; and

WHEREAS, the vision of the Nevada Healthy Homes Partnership is to identify such unhealthy conditions in the home environment and address said conditions by reducing asthma triggers, preventing unintentional injuries, eliminate poisoning hazards, and repairing structural deficiencies, thereby improving the overall health and quality of life for Nevada residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition supports the mission and vision of the Nevada Healthy Homes Partnership; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition does hereby support the Nevada Healthy Homes Partnership to pursue grant opportunities to further develop the Healthy Homes Initiative in the State of Nevada.


