

**RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE STATE BALLOT QUESTION 2 AND  
RECOMMENDING AN ALTERNATIVE PROCESS**

**WHEREAS**, the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition, an organization of public entities in Southern Nevada, is concerned with the substantial negative impact that State Ballot Question 2 will have on:


- Growth and the economy;
- The ability of local governments to provide necessary public infrastructure;
- The cost to the taxpayers of that infrastructure; and
- The ability to comply with federal regulations necessary to obtain federal funding.

**WHEREAS**, member agencies of the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition have resolved to never use eminent domain to transfer property from one private party to another private party; thereby making the intent of the initiative moot.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition Board opposes this ballot initiative and recommends an alternative that addresses the Kelo decision be developed through a deliberative legislative process, [which will address the Kelo decision,] without including the other provisions which carry so much potential harm to the taxpayers, motorists and homeowners of Nevada.


