

Comprehensive Affordable Housing Strategy Collaborative: The [Redevelopment Agency](#) in cooperation with the [San Diego Housing Commission](#) assembled the Comprehensive Affordable Housing Strategy Collaborative (the "Collaborative"). The Collaborative established priorities to increase affordable housing inventory for families while providing for development of other affordable housing such as senior housing and supportive services housing for the mentally ill. Resources for the Collaborative's strategy come from tax increment funds set aside for low and moderate income housing by the [City Redevelopment Division](#), [Centre City Development Corporation](#), and [Southeastern Economic Development Corporation](#). The San Diego Housing Commission provides project management support in areas of the City that are not in the redevelopment areas. In January 2003, the Collaborative issued its first Notice of Availability for \$55 million. ([Redevelopment Agency](#), [San Diego Housing Commission](#))
